Essentials

The Holy Spirit isn't <u>optional</u>. He is <u>essential</u>.

"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. 2Now the earth was void and without form and, darkness covered the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters. 3And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light."

(Gen. 1:1-3)

"Then God said, "Let us make mankind in our image, in our likeness," (Gen. 1:26)

- · Walking with the Holy Spirit helps us not give into temptation.
 - o (Gal. 5:16
- The Holy Spirit convicts us when we're doing the wrong things
 - (John 16:8-11)
- · He gives incredible spiritual gifts
 - (1 Corinthians 12, Rom.12, Eph. 4:11-16)
- The Holy Spirit produces supernatural results the Fruit of the Spirit
 - (Gal. 5:22-23)

""I have much more to say to you, more than you can now bear. 13But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come. 14He will glorify me by taking what is mine and making it known to you." (John 16:12-14)

1. The Holy Spirit brings *clarity*.

"these are the things God has revealed to us by his Spirit. The Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God. 12What we have received is not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may understand what God has freely given us...

14The person without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God but considers them foolishness, and cannot understand them because they are discerned only through the Spirit." (1 Cor. 2:10-14)







2. The Holy Spirit *confirms* and reassures our place as *family*.

"Because you are his sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, "Abba, Father." 7So you are no longer a slave, but God's child;" (Gal. 4:6)

"The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father." 16The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children".

(Rom.8:15-16)

3. The Holy Spirit stands with us.

"Our enemy's greatest tactic isn't temptation or attack it's accusation". (Rev. 12:10)

"and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin...9If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness."

(1 John 1:7-9)

"So now there is no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. 2And because you belong to him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death." (Rom. 8:1-2)

25 "All this I have spoken while still with you. 26But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you." (John 14:25-26)

 The Accuser knows your <u>name</u> but call you by your <u>sin</u>, God knows your <u>sin</u> but calls you by your <u>name</u>.

27"Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid." (John 14:27)
