2 Chronicles 10:1

Rehoboam went to Shechem, for all Israel had gone there to make him king.

2 Chronicles 10:3-4

So they sent for Jeroboam, and he and all Israel went to Rehoboam and said to him:

2 Chronicles 10:8-11

The young men who had grown up with him replied, "The people have said to you, 'Your father put a heavy yoke on us, but make our yoke lighter.' Now tell them, 'My little finger is thicker than my father's waist.

2 Chronicles 10:8-11

My father laid on you a heavy yoke; I will make it even heavier. My father scourged you with whips; I will scourge you with scorpions.' "
