Principles of Fall

1. Fall is a season of excitement & urgency

John 4:35

You have a saying, 'It's still four months until harvest'? I tell you, open your eyes and look at the fields! They are white unto harvest.

If you don't reap,
it will rot.

John 4:38

I sent you to reap what you have not labored for; others have labored, and you have entered into their labors."

Principles of Fall

2. Fall reveals reality.

Proverbs 20:4

The lazy do not plow in season;
so at harvest time they look but find nothing.

Galatians 6:7

Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows.

Principles of Fall

3. You reap what you sow.

Hebrews 12:11

No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it.

Galatians 6:8

Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction; whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life.

Principles of Fall

4. We reap how we sow.

2 Corinthians 9:6

Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously.

Principles of Fall

What you harvest in fall
feeds you through winter.

Proverbs 21:20

In the house of the wise are stores of choice food and oils,
but the foolish devours all they have.

Proverbs 10:5

A wise son stores up for the winter months,
but a shameful son lies around even during harvest.

2 Corinthians 9:8

And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.

2 Corinthians 9:10-11

Now he who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will also supply and increase your store of seed and will enlarge the harvest of your righteousness.

2 Corinthians 9:10-11

You will be enriched in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God.

Psalm 126:5-6

Those who sow with tears
will reap with joy.

Psalm 126:5-6

Those who go out weeping,
carrying seed to sow,
will return with songs of joy,
carrying the harvest with them.
